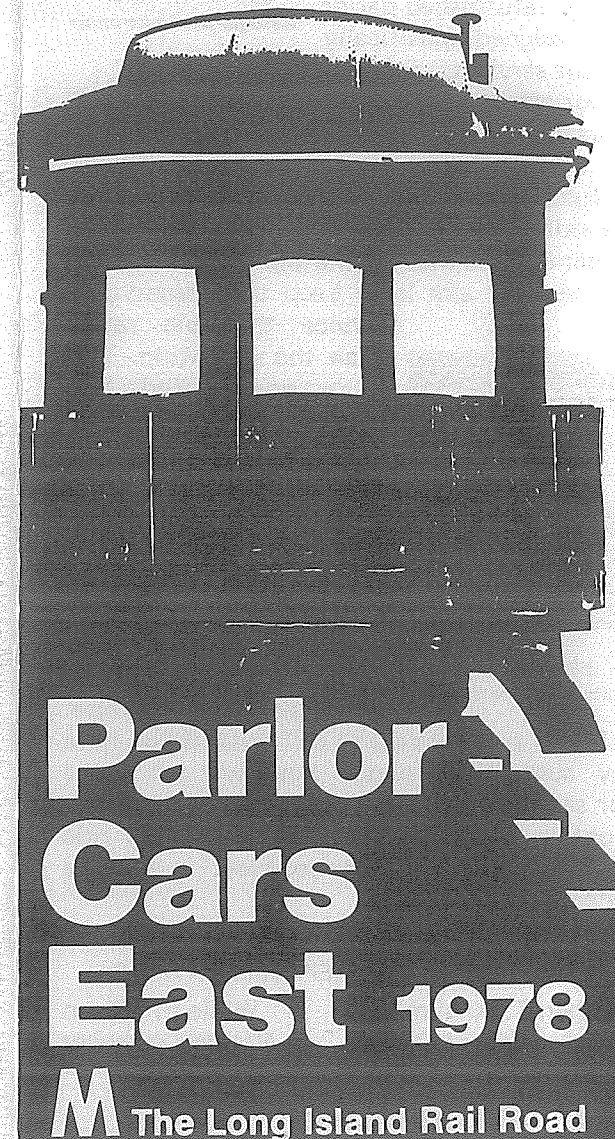

Twenty years later in 1977 we introduced our "Sunrise Fleet" of completely refurbished parlor cars designed specifically for our services.

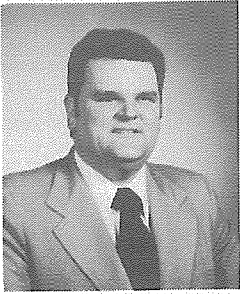
Our efforts are to provide the most efficient, courteous and comfortable service available on any transportation network in the country.

Our files are full of commendations from the riding public on our supervisory and attendant personnel in the parlor and bar car service. Our aim is to keep this standard of

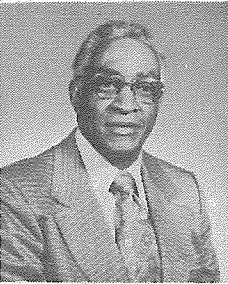
service the rule rather than the exception. This is a personalized first class service and we intend to operate it as such.

Fares

Your one way coach ticket PLUS \$6.50 allows you to ride in the roomy air-conditioned comfort of a LIRR parlor car.

And there's even more savings if you ride before the peak hours on weekdays or any-time on Sundays and holidays. Take advantage of LIRR off-peak fares. (See our price list elsewhere in this guide.)

Regular one way fares apply to all trains in the SHADED area of the timetable.

Reservations

We urge you to make your reservations as far in advance as possible, especially if you plan to travel for the entire season.

Parlor car tickets may not be altered or reused, once a reservation has been confirmed. If you find it necessary to cancel reservations, please call either of the above numbers.

Requests for cancellations will be honored up to train time at the originating station. When you call to cancel a reservation, the passenger agent will assign you a cancellation number. This number should be written across the front of the ticket and the ticket may then be turned in for refund at your local station or by mailing to LIRR, Box 383, Jamaica, NY 11435.

No cancellation numbers will be given after train departure. Any confirmed parlor car reservation ticket without proper cancellation number will result in a reduction in redemption value of \$6.50 off the prices listed in the accompanying fare chart.

Procedures

To avoid duplicate reservations we have established specific Reservation CUT-OFF Times. Phone reservations will NOT be accepted after train CUT-OFF Time:

Train 12—2:30 PM Friday 206—4:00 PM Friday
14—2:30 PM Friday 18—5:00 PM Friday
16—4:00 PM Friday 20—6:00 PM Friday

After these times seats will be assigned on a first come, first served basis.
